LONG HOUSE CULTURAL TOURS



Visit a long house either for the day or stay overnight in the communal housing of Sarawak's indigenous peoples.

Start off your trip with an informative visit to the Sarawak Cultural Village, which features seven authentic long houses and traditional dwellings. Learn about the culture of Sarawak's indigenous peoples. Dance performance included.



For the adventurous, go upcountry for an extended stay in a traditional Orang Ulu or Iban long house community. This gives you the chance to experience the traditional life.

GAWAI FESTIVAL - The end of May is Gawai. The indigenous people of Sarawak, the Ibans and Bidayus celebrate the end of Padi Harvesting Season with merry-making, dancing, and the drinking of Tuak, a potent rice wine. There is feasting and fun for all. Guest are welcome to join in the traditional dances and fun in the many longhouses.

A special two day hands on artists' work shop with some of Sarawak's leading artists. Learn how to create batik on silk and how to create clothing and handicrafts. of the indigenous people. Wrap up your experiences with a traditional longhouse barbecue and party.

Turtle Island

Spend the night watching sea turtles lay thier eggs and then observe the baby turtles make their way back to sea.



Clearwater Cave, Asia's longest underground river system, and the King's Chamber at

Wind Cave. Swim in the crystal clear water at the natural pool outside the cave. Walk the entrance of Deer and Lang's caves on a plank walk that passes through lowland Peatswamp forest. Deer cave is the world's largest cave passage, plus see a natural profile of US President Abraham Lincoln. Return to the cave entrance before proceeding to the the bat's platform to witness the exit of millions of insect eating bats from Deer cave at sunset. Walk through the forest at dusk to the Park HQ before transferring back to the resort.
